CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules & regulations are for the protection & benefit of all users of the club's facilities and are designed to assure safe and sanitary operation of our club. All state and local laws will apply. It is the responsibility of all members, guests and their children to observe all rules and to obey the instructions of the lifeguards on duty and club management. Infraction of any of these rules may result in assignment to penalty area or expulsion by lifeguards on duty or club management. Continued failure to comply with these rules may result in suspension of club privileges by the Board of Directors.

Disciplinary actions for infraction of pool rules:

1. Lifeguards as well as Pool Management may suspend all privileges for up to one day.
2. Pool Management must approve suspension of all privileges for up to 3 days.
3. Board of Directors must approve any suspension and of privileges over 3 days.

Members are responsible for their guests. The cost of any property damage or expense incurred through violation of the operating rules by a member or member of his/her household, or his/her guest, will be charged to the member responsible. The Board of Directors will determine what action to take against those that will not assume responsibility for said damage or expense. The club cannot be responsible for loss or damage to personal property. *(Please see Starclaire Park Club, Inc's Trespassing Policy)*

All guests shall be introduced to and registered with lifeguards on duty and club management by a member in good standing prior to using the club's facilities. No one is allowed in the club office, concession area or the chemical room/pump area except those authorized by club management.

Pool Rules

1. The pool may be closed or hours may be changed by club management due to weather or other situations when deemed necessary.
2. No hanging on lifelines, buoys or lane markers.
3. Members and guests are not to engage in social conversations with the lifeguards while they are on duty. *(This is a distraction and can affect the safety of all persons using the pool)*
4. Admission may be refused to anyone with colds, communicable diseases, coughs, infections, inflamed eyes, skin abrasions or wearing bandages.

5. A shower is required before entering the pool. Parents, please remind children to use the toilet facilities when necessary.
6. **No** pets will be allowed in the pool area. *(See rule #41)*
7. Food must be stored and consumed in the clubhouse only, and is not allowed in the pool area during regular pool hours. Chewing gum will not be permitted while in the swimming pool. All trash must be placed in the proper receptacles.
8. Towels and clothing left around the pool and in the clubhouse will be placed into a lost and found bin. Lost and found items will be discarded each week, on Wednesday, when the pool closes.
9. For safety reasons, the following cannot be permitted while in the pool area: running, spitting, ball throwing, horseplay, pushing, dunking, wrestling, etc...
10. Non-adult, non-swimmers shall **not** be permitted to use the swimming pool unless accompanied by a parent or other responsible person who shall keep constant watch on the non-swimmer. A "swimmer" is one aged 9 or over who has passed the Red Cross Advance Beginner's Swimming Test or who can demonstrate to the Pool Management a swimming ability comparable to the advanced beginner. Children who cannot swim must remain in the roped off shallow area at all times unless accompanied in the water by a parent or other responsible person.
11. During "Adult Swim", only persons 16 years of age and older may use the pool. The purpose of "Adult Swim" is to provide younger people with a 10-minute break in swimming activity. The baby pool is not to be used as a play area during adult swim time by children who have been using the big pool. Parents who wish to accompany their children, under the age of two (2), into the big pool during "Adult Swim" may do so with the understanding that **NO GUARDS** will be in the stand at that time.
12. No free swimming in the diving area will be allowed unless approved and supervised by a Lifeguard on duty. Entry into the diving area will be from the diving boards only.
13. Diving board use is restricted to swimmers that are skilled enough to jump safely and swim unassisted to the ladders. Only one person will be permitted on the diving board at a time. No hanging from or horseplay on the diving board is allowed.
14. No excessive bouncing allowed on diving boards unless during supervised diving lessons and/or competition.

15. Artificial swimming aids are allowed while accompanied by a parent or responsible person. No floats allowed except during club-sponsored events. Fins and goggles are allowed.
16. Swim suits only. No cut-off jeans are allowed.

Wading Pool Rules

17. All applicable pool rules apply.
18. The wading pool is for children 6 years of age and under.
19. A parent or other responsible person must supervise children at all times. No guards on duty in wading pool area.
20. The wading pool shall not be open for use during Swim Team events.
21. Parents are asked that their children's toys be removed from the wading pool when leaving the area.
22. **No** smoking allowed in wading pool area.

Swim Team

23. Nights of home Swim Meets the pool will close at 5:00 PM. There will be no open swimming during or after the meets.
24. Only those authorized shall be allowed in the pool area before and during Swim Team events.
25. Swim Team may practice during open hours. Swimming will be allowed only in the areas assigned by club management during Swim Team practice. Any harassment or interference of Swim Team practice may result in the loss of pool privileges for the rest of the day.

Badges

26. Membership badges must be accessible at all times when on club property. Pool management and/or lifeguards will have the right to ask for and verify identification of any person using the club's facilities. *(Please refer to Starclaire Park Club, Inc's Trespassing Policy)*
27. Badges shall not to be shared. If a badge is lost or stolen a lost badge form must be submitted with applicable fees. *(First badge – free, subsequent badges shall cost \$5.00)* Replacement badges shall be marked as duplicate.

28. All registered guests shall be allowed on pool property upon the sponsorship of a member in good standing. *(For further clarification, please refer to Starclaire Park Club, Inc's Guest Fee policy)*
29. Members and guests are not required to display badges during; adult, teen, preteen parties, special functions or swim team league competitions.
30. Each member will be required to log in at the check-in counter with the lifeguard on duty or pool management before entering the pool area.
31. Registered guests must wear and display wristbands at all times while on club property.

Facilities

32. Applicable dues that cannot be processed due to insufficient funds shall result in suspension of club privileges until paid in full. A \$35.00 returned check fee shall apply.
33. The club phone is intended as a privilege for our members. It is not to be abused or used for social calls. Please limit all calls to one minute. The clubs management may revoke the phone privilege for incoming or outgoing calls for misuse.
34. Glass or other breakable objects are **not** permitted inside the main gate
35. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed on club property at any time **except** during youth events where league by-laws prevent the use of alcohol. *(State law prohibits the use of alcoholic beverages by any persons under the age of 21)* Anyone abusing these rules will be asked to leave the premise and\or the police will be called. All alcoholic beverages must be in a plastic cup or in a koozie. *(see rule #34)*
36. All bicycles must be parked in the bike area.
37. Motorized vehicle riding is **not** permitted anywhere on the club property, except to enter or leave the facility.
38. Skateboards and bikes are **not** permitted in the pool area at any time or on the sidewalks during normal pool hours and special functions.
39. Golf practice on lawn area is prohibited.
40. Members and guests shall drive slowly while in the parking lot and park their cars properly between the marked lines in the parking area.
41. Pet owners shall be responsible for all pets on club grounds. This shall include but not limited to picking up after them while they are on club property. *(see rule #6)*

42. Associate Members have full use of the grounds with the exception of use of the pool as defined in “Associate Membership FAQs” and are governed by Starclaire Bylaws, Member & Guest Fee Policies, Club Rules & Regulations, Trespassing Policies and Tennis Rules.

TRESPASSING POLICY

The Starclaire Swim and Tennis Club grounds are intended for the sole purpose of its member's enjoyment year round. The club reserves the right to ask any individual to leave club grounds for not holding a membership in good standing at Starclaire Swim and Tennis (Starclaire Park Club, Inc.). Any person on Starclaire grounds must have their membership card with them at all times and be able to produce it if asked by club management, life guards or members of the law enforcement community.

Any individuals on pool grounds who can not provide the proper identification that they are members may be asked to leave by pool management, life guards or the law enforcement community. This shall be in effect 24 hrs per day, 365 days per year. Non-members that are not the registered guests of a member will be considered a trespasser and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Also, any damages incurred from a trespasser will be prosecuted under the law. Please refer back to the pool rules for any clarification on membership badges, guest policies and proper use of the pool grounds.

Again, these facilities are solely for the intended use of our members and their registered guests. It is the job of management to make sure that we are providing a safe and fun atmosphere for our members and their families. Please follow these rules and policies to insure we continue to have a wonderful place to enjoy for years to come.

STARCLAIRE PARK CLUB TENNIS RULES

1. All players shall sign the blackboard upon arrival at the courts indicating the court and starting time. Advance reservations of the courts will not be allowed except for tournament and challenge matches (or other events approved by the tennis committee), which must be at least 1-1/2 hours in advance. A player's name may not appear on the sign in board more than once at any given time. Use first initial, and erase name when play is completed.
2. If there are waiting players, singles play will be limited to one hour and doubles play will be limited to 1-1/2 hours.
3. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF WAITING PLAYERS TO NOTIFY THOSE PLAYING AT THE EXPIRATION OF TIME ON A PARTICULAR COURT.** Courts should be surrendered immediately at the expiration of time so as not to infringe on the time of others. The clock at the end of the clubhouse is to be considered the correct time.
4. A "TM" in front of the starting time will indicate it is a tournament match and play will continue until the match is completed.
5. Court #4 shall be designated for challenge matches, which shall be played until completion. This shall be the only court that may be reserved in advance for challenge matches. Any challenge match played on court #1 and #2 will have a time limit of 1 hour if others are waiting. "CM" should precede sign ups for challenge matches.
6. One person will not be permitted to hold a court.
7. Two or more players of a scheduled doubles match may take a court at the appointed time, but will receive no time extension due to late arrival of balance of foursome. If foursome is not completed by the end of one hour, the court will be surrendered at that time.
8. Adult players shall have priority on courts #1, #2 and #4 on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays; as well as after 5:00PM on weekdays. Junior players are not required to yield if playing on a court with one or more adults. Junior players shall have priority on court #3 at all times except for league play, tournament play and 8-A ruling. Adult players are required to yield court #3 to juniors, even if playing with juniors. Time limit on court #3 shall be 1 hour for singles and 1-1/2 hours for doubles. Anyone 18 years or under is considered a junior.
9. Anyone who is not playing tennis will not be permitted on the courts while others are playing.
10. Non-marking Tennis shoes are required and men will wear shirts.
11. **TENNIS COURTS MUST REMAIN LOCKED WHEN NOT IN USE.** Players

using the courts are responsible for **LOCKING GATES AFTER PLAY**. Last person leaving at night is responsible for **TURNING OFF LIGHTS** and **LOCKING THE MAIN GATE**.

12. The Tennis Committee, Club Officers, Pool Manager and Lifeguards are authorized and directed to enforce all rules and cooperation of all members is requested.
13. No skateboards, roller blades or bicycles are permitted on the tennis courts.
14. Membership tags will be displayed at all times.
15. Those requesting only will be issued keys to the tennis courts. Replacement keys in the event of loss will cost whatever the cost is to duplicate.
16. For the safety of all users the tennis courts shall be closed during lightning and severe weather. **BE AWARE** – wait 30 minutes after storm passes to resume activities.

Note: On Saturday and Sunday adults may sign up on court #3 and finish play; however, no adult may sign up after those adults playing until it is determined that two juniors are not waiting for the court.
